Amir Ashrafi Habibabadi

and his wife, Fatemeh Ghasemi Dastjerdi, were among 176 lives that perished on board Ukrainian International Airlines flight PS752.

Amir was a doctoral student and assistant at the Institute of Fluid Dynamics, Department of Mechanical and Process Engineering, ETH Zurich. He was an active member of InterPore. He participated in InterPore2019 in Valencia, May 2019, where he gave a presentation.
